



PSX preparation guide

Five points for using PSX for a long time

Preparing for this unit can be easily done by anyone who has experience connecting a VCR to come.

However, unlike conventional VCRs, this unit does not support precision devices such as hard disks.

Because it is equipped with a machine,

If you do the preparation work without knowing some precautions, you may damage the machine or make it work incorrectly. recording may not be possible.

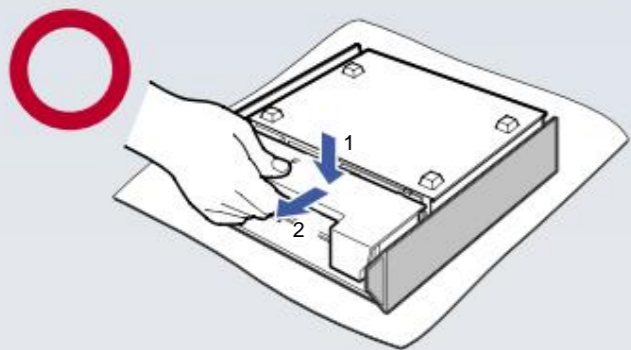
In order to ensure that you will be able to use this unit satisfactorily after preparations have been made, be sure to observe the following five points. be prepared.

**Point 1** Precautions when connecting

If you connect this unit incorrectly, the hard disk of this unit may be damaged or the antenna may be damaged. You may. Be sure to observe the following cautions.

When connecting, connect with the top side of the unit facing down.

1 Push the once, then 2 Pull it forward.

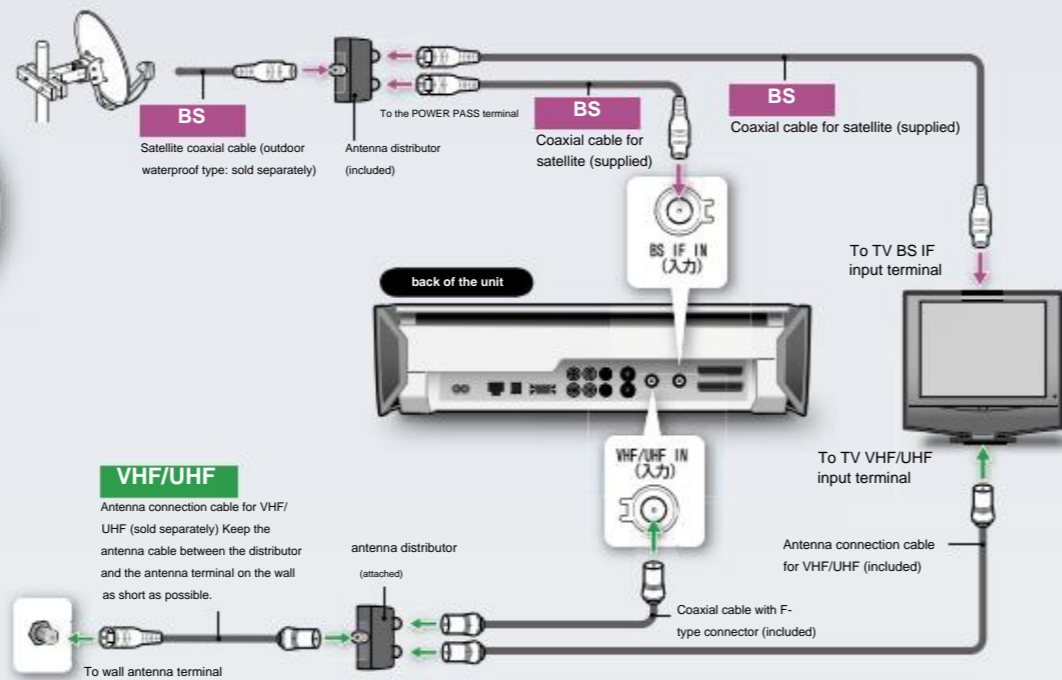


If you use the included distributor, you can also connect the antenna to the TV.

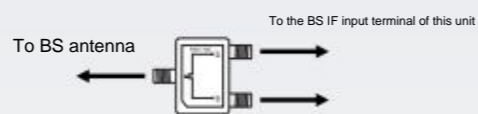
This unit does not have an antenna output terminal.

Must use. This unit comes with two distributors. Please connect na.

Connect the supplied cable to the BS IF input terminal.



When supplying power from this unit to the BS antenna, connect the terminal labeled POWER PASS on the distributor to the BS IF input terminal of this unit.



When supplying power to the BS antenna on the TV side, connect the terminal labeled POWER PASS on the distributor to the BS IF input terminal on the TV.



See page 16 of the Owner's Manual for connection to the TV using the AV cord.

When this unit and TV are connected with a video cord or S-video cord, set the progressive output setting of this unit to "Off".

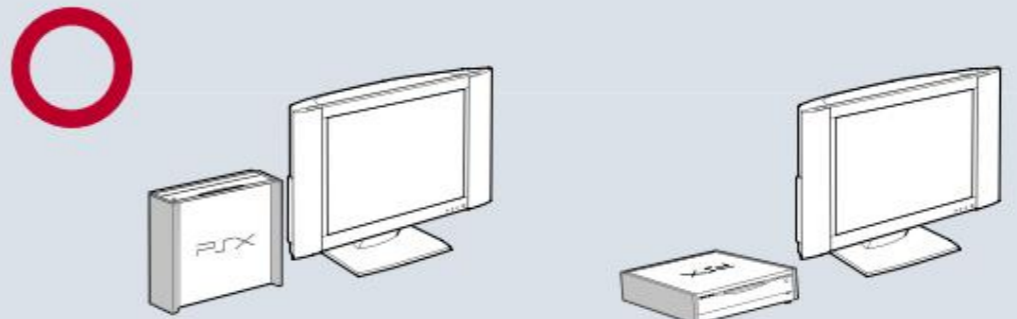
Select "On" in "Set progressive output" (page 101) in "DVD settings" of this unit. No image is displayed even if output is output. In such cases, leave the setting as "Off". If DVD images are not displayed, please check the progressive output setting.

**Point 2** Installation point

This unit can be placed horizontally or vertically, but discs such as CDs and DVDs will not work properly if placed in any other way than specified.

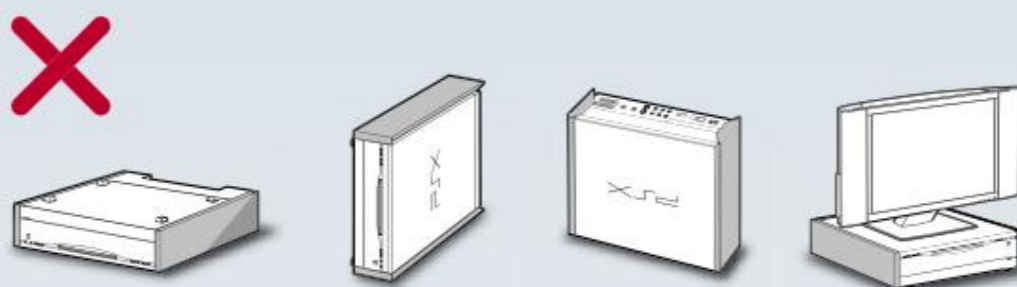
Be sure to install the unit according to the correct installation method.

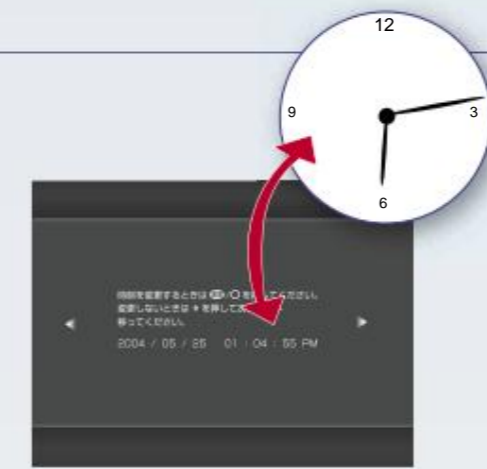


**Point 3** Precautions for "Easy Setup"

When the connection and installation are completed and the power of this unit is turned on for the first time, the simple setting screen is displayed. You can set it simply by following the instructions displayed on the screen, but if you make a mistake in the setting, you will not be able to use the program guide correctly. increase. Be sure to observe the following cautions.

Please set the time correctly

If the time is not set correctly, you may not be able to receive the program guide data or the scheduled recording may not work on time. The unit is shipped from the factory with the time set in advance, but just in case, check that the current time matches the unit's time. For details, see page 20 of the Owner's Manual.



Please also check the channel settings automatically set in the area code setting just in case.

If you do not select the correct area code for your area in the default area code setting, the program guide will not be displayed correctly. It may not be set and you may not be able to schedule recording.

Also, in the following cases, manual channel setting is required to obtain the program guide data. Please note that it may become

- The displayed channel in the guide channel list (page 136 of the instruction manual) is different from the TV channel
- If you are using cable TV or an apartment community reception system, etc., the guide channel list display channel is different

**Point 4** Point of reception of program guide

Data such as program names to be displayed in the program guide is sent several times a day from a specific TV station through the TV antenna. provided periodically. This unit stores program guide data when it is turned off or when you are playing a game on this unit.

The program guide cannot be used at the time of purchase.

At the time of purchase, program guide data is not stored in this unit, so the program guide cannot be used until the power is turned off and the program guide data is received. If you change the area code, get the program information of the program guide. The time to start is also set automatically. Please turn off the power during the time period to be acquired.

For the acquisition time, see Settings: TV settings (page 96). change the set time please don't



Precautions regarding acquisition of program guide data

•Program guide data can only be obtained when this unit is turned off or when a game is being used on this unit. Only when Otherwise, the program guide cannot be obtained.

•When you use this unit for the first time after purchase, the program guide data will not be displayed until the program guide is downloaded. The time it takes to send program guide data is determined by the broadcasting station (host station) that sends the program guide data. It may take several days.

You can enjoy the functions of this unit other than the program guide even when the data of the program guide is not obtained.

•Depending on the radio wave conditions and the occurrence of ghosts, it may not be possible to acquire the program guide data.

**Point 5** Points for handling this machine

For basic preparation of this unit, refer to "Preparation 1 Checking the Accessories" to "Preparation 7 Easy Setup" in the Operating Instructions. If you have completed the above, you are finished, but if you do not observe the following precautions while using the unit, it may lead to a malfunction of the unit.

Do not pull out the power cord or move the main unit when the power is on.

Hard disks have built-in safety mechanisms to protect data from vibrations, shocks, and dust, but improper use can result in loss of recorded data or damage. In particular, be sure to observe the following precautions. - Do not move the unit or change its orientation while the power cord is plugged in. - When you plug or unplug the power cord or turn the power on and off, immediately move or move the do not Wait about 20 seconds after turning off the power.

Make sure that there is no disc in this unit before inserting the disc.

If you try to insert a disc while it is inside the unit, the disc may be damaged. I will.

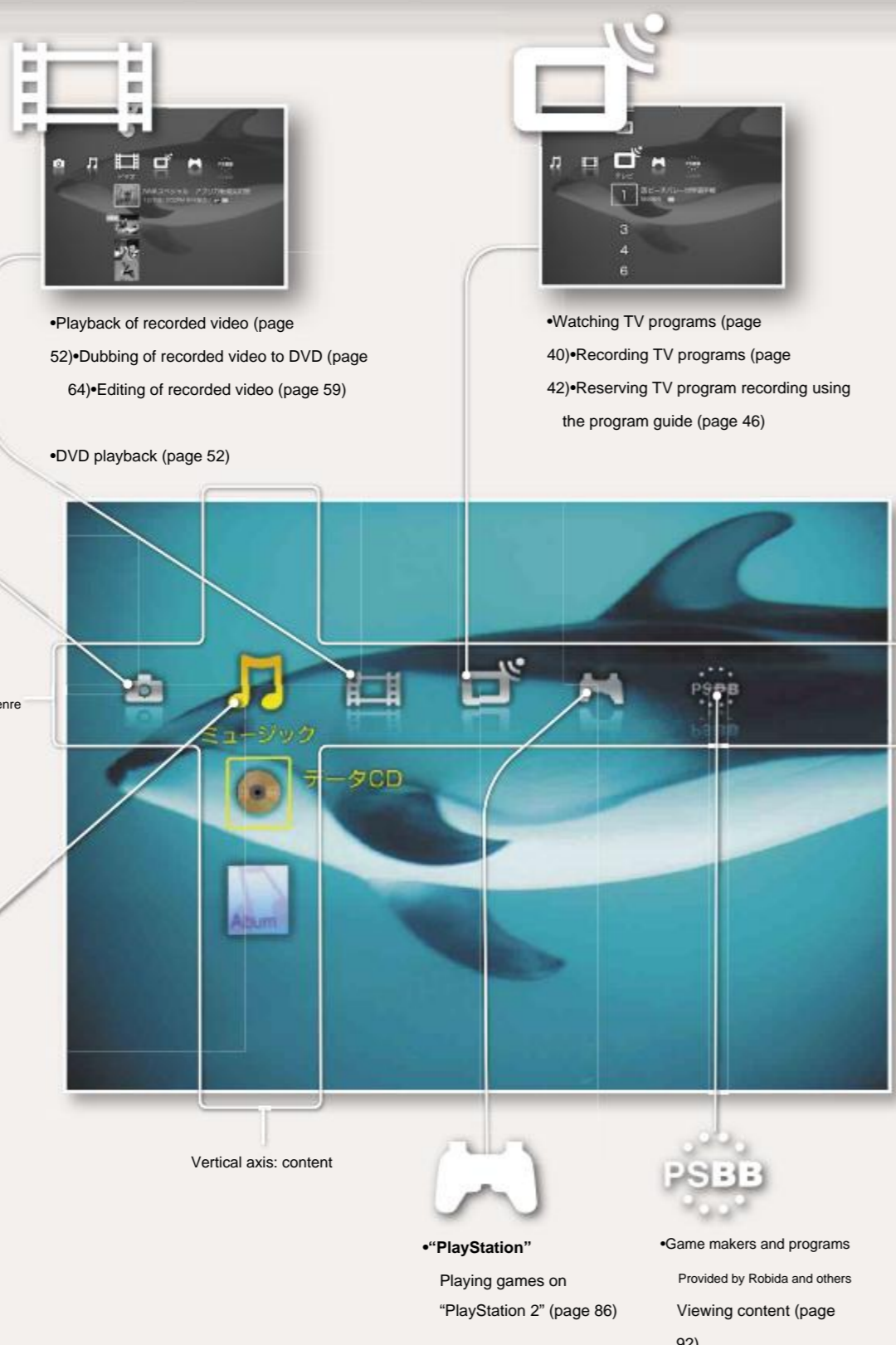
